

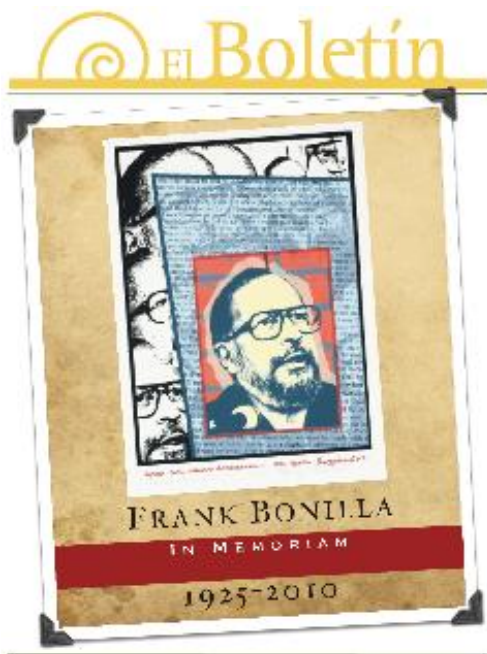

**CENTRO DIRECTOR SEARCH**

The search committee for the Centro Director organized and hosted the campus visits and interviews of the four finalists. The finalists emerged from a national search that yielded a diverse and distinguished pool of applicants. The finalists spent a full day on the Hunter College campus which culminated in a public address that outlined their vision for Centro and explained how their scholarship and community involvement inform that vision. On December 7th the Search Committee met with Hunter College President Jennifer J. Kuhl and presented their summary recommendations. The search then entered the negotiations stage of the process between the President and the finalists. News of the President's decision will be widely disseminated.
